

Winemaking & Tasting:

Rooted in marine sedimentary soil deep in the cool coastal foothills, this 6-acre, own-rooted vineyard was planted in 1988 by William Bednarik to Pommard and Wadenswil clones of Pinot Noir. A dry winter and warm spring led into a warm growing season ending with a dry fall.

Handpicked on September 20th & 26th, the grapes were broken up into five lots with varying percentages of whole cluster. Grapes were fermented with indigenous yeast and aged in oak for 11 months. Then they were moved gently to bottle, unfined and unfiltered.

This Pinot Noir is layered with ripe cranberries, sweet red fruits, and floral aromas that accompany the refined and silky palate.
