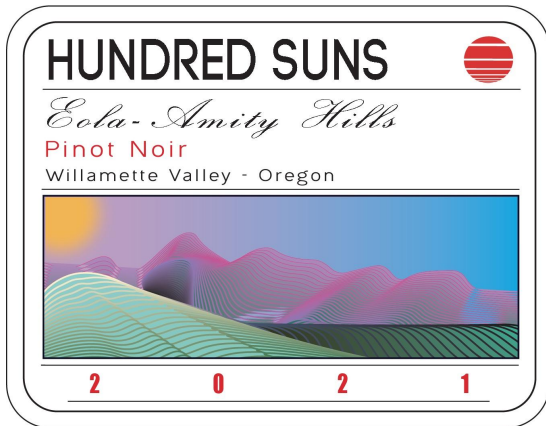

Winemaking & Tasting:

The 2021 season started with a drier than normal winter, early spring and warm summer temperatures. Cool fall weather created perfect conditions to pick our collections of dry farmed vineyards in Eola-Amity Hills.

This Pinot Noir consists of 20% Koosah Vineyard and 80% Big Cheese Vineyard, planted on the rocky volcanic soils and cooled by pacific ocean breezes.

Moderate yields and small berries made for intense flavors of blue fruits, sassafras, and rich round textures. Winemaking was kept to a bare minimum: fermented with native yeast and 35% whole cluster, aged on the lees for 11 months then gently racked to tank and bottled unfinned and unfiltered.
